### **CHEST X RAY PA VIEW**

#### **FINDINGS:**

1. Thick walled cavity noted in the right lower lobe superior segment. No fluid level seen. Surrounding lung parenchyma shows spiculation and patchy consolidation. Rest of the right lower lobe shows hazy opacification. Minimal volume loss noted in the right lower lobe as evidenced by the lower position of the right hilum.
2. Right hilum appears dense s/o possible underlying lymph nodes
3. Mild right pleural effusion
4. Rest of the right lung ( upper and middle lobes) and the left lung show no abnormality.No nodules seen.
5. Left hilum is normal in position, contour and density.
6. Mediastinal contour appears normal.
7. Bony thoracic cage and rest of the visualised bones show no abnormality

#### **IMPRESSION:**

1. Thick walled cavity in superior segment of right lower lobe with surrounding spiculation & consolidation and minimal volume loss of right lower lobe. Needs further evaluation with CT thorax.
2. Possible right hilar lymph nodes
3. Mild right pleural effusion
